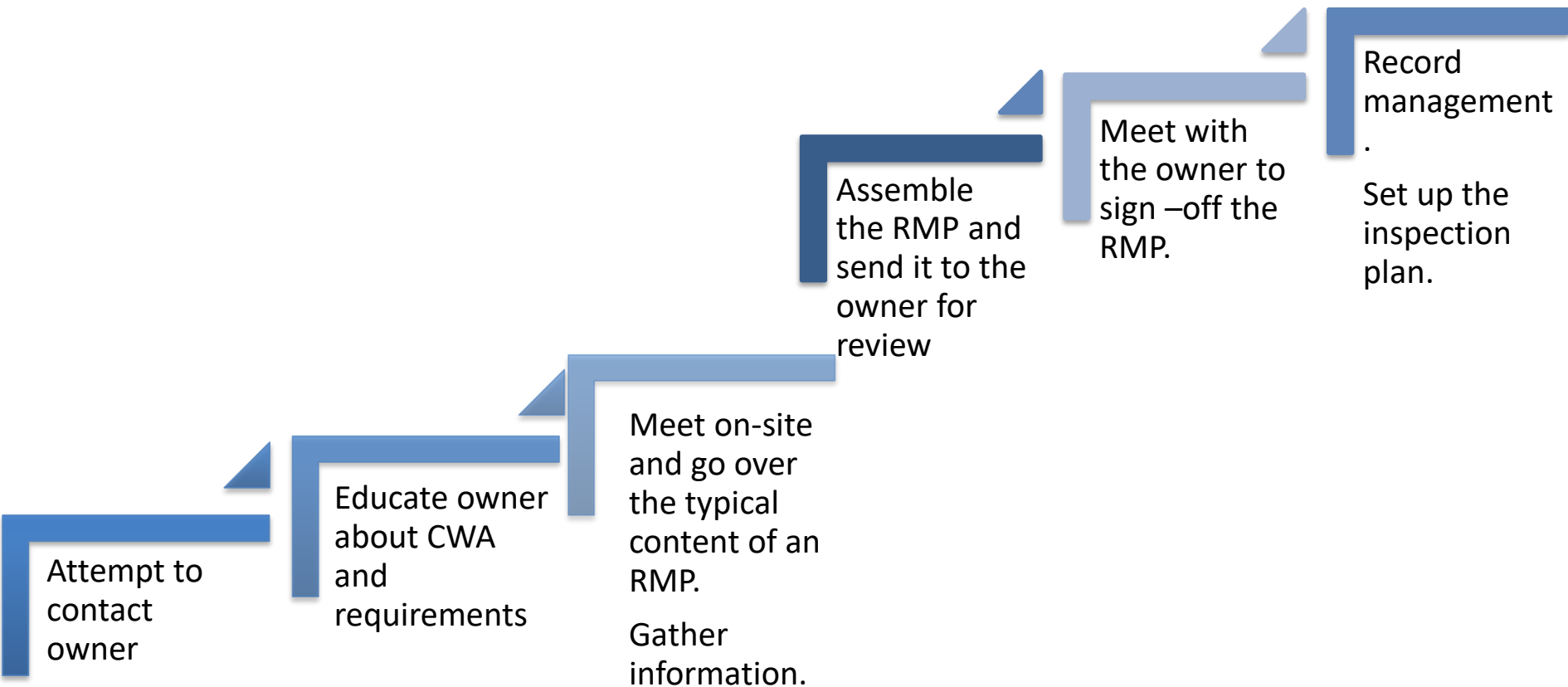
# Risk Management Plans – Outstanding

- 7 RMPs on 3 properties
- RMPs for 2 properties are in progress
- RMPs relate to Management or handling of Agricultural Source Material (ASM) generation (Grazing and pasturing), pathogen and chemical threat.

- Part 2 – Source Protection Program Information
- Part 3 – Landowner/Operator Responsibilities
- Part 4 – City of Hamilton Responsibilities
  - Schedule 1 – Summary of Consultation
  - Schedule 2 – Site Activities and Existing Risk Management Measures
  - Schedule 3 – Additional Risk Management Measures Proposed
  - Schedule 4 – Monitoring & Reporting Program
  - Schedule 5 – Contingency and Emergency Response Plan
  - Schedule 6 – Communications Plan
  - Schedule 7 – Special Considerations (optional)
- Part 5 – Agreement on a Risk Management Plan

# Risk Management Plans – Next Steps

- Continue to negotiate the RMPs with the 2 property owners this fall
- Consider an extension for the RMPs for the 3<sup>rd</sup> property.
- Implement the inspection process
- Consider new potential significant drinking water threats based on changes in land use and Section 59 screening process
